

## LIABILITY DISCLAIMER

This disclaimer sets out your obligations to operate the step-stairs facility in a correct and safe manner. You are signing this document to confirm you understand that the safety points below must be adhered to and that you will use the step-stairs at your own risk. You agree to indemnify the company against any loss, injury, damage to you or your property and will not hold the company responsible now or any time in the future for any loss or damage incurred. You are also agreeing to comply with the safety points below.

A member of staff will demonstrate how to use the step-stairs and instructions given on use MUST be adhered to by you. There is also a copy of instructions located on each set of step-stairs for your reminder.

Failure to comply with the instructions could cause you serious injury and it is imperative you follow the instructions set out to you.

The following important safety points must be adhered to without fail:-

- NO CHILDREN are allowed on or up the step-stairs.
- ONE PERSON at a time is allowed on the step-stairs.
- The Step-Stairs must be LOCKED DOWN BEFORE USE
- Please ensure the GATE IS CLOSED BEHIND YOU when climbing the stairs and after use.
- DO NOT carry loads above 15kg in weight.
- Only climb steps using the treads or top platform
- ALWAYS climb using the handrails for stability
- DO NOT stand on any of the framework other than the treads
- Always ensure the stairs are in the correct position to align with the platform with no gaps either side.
- BEFORE moving the stairs please call out to ensure no clients are in other areas of the mezzanine.
- If you notice any damage or if the step-stairs are difficult to move in any way please do not use and notify a member of staff IMMEDIATELY.

Please note the above points are clearly labelled on the side of the step- stairs for your easy reference.
